Project Spotlight - Lost Battlefield of Etoa

The Lost Battlefield of Etoa in Papua New Guinea is a significant but fragile site associated with the Kokoda Campaign of 1942. The difficult terrain, presence of human remains, soldiers' weapons, personal effects and unexploded ordinance all combine to create a complex yet fascinating heritage site.

Kokoda is one of the most significant Australian wartime sites. The story of Kokoda is one that should be remembered - it encompasses mateship, courage, and sacrifice.

Extent Heritage carried out an archaeological survey of the battlefield, identifying artefacts and earthworks, in connection with local oral histories which expanded our understanding of this significant site in Australia's military history. The project included completing a Heritage Management Plan which identified the significant aspects of the site and provides practical management options for the future.
